



- STEP 1** Go to my.ucf.edu and log in with your NID credentials
 - STEP 2** Click on **Academic Resources** and then click on **GPA Estimator**.
 - STEP 3** Use the information from your most recent **UCF Cumulative GPA** to fill in **credit hours** and **GPA**.
Find UCF Cumulative GPA through myUCF → Student Self Service → Other academic menu → Grades
 - STEP 4** Use the **plus/minus** buttons to adjust the number of classes you are currently taking
Exclude courses that use S/U grading, that you have withdrawn from, or you anticipate earning a NC grade
 - STEP 5** Insert the number of **credit hours** for each course

- STEP 6A** If using **Desired GPA** box, put in your GPA goal and leave the **Class Grades** boxes blank
 - STEP 7A** Click **calculate** and it will generate the minimum grades needed in the **Class Grades** boxes or will give you the message that **it is impossible to reach that GPA** in the **message box**
-
- STEP 6B** To calculate the GPA for your current grade estimates, leave the **Desired GPA** box blank and use the **Class Grade** drop-down menus to select a grade for each class
 - STEP 7B** Click **calculate** and it will generate a **Class GPA** (GPA of courses in **Class Information** box) and an **Estimated GPA** (GPA of courses in **Class Information** and **Current Information** boxes)
